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
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A crown is an artificial cover commonly known as "dental caps". It is a dental restoration, which encases a whole tooth and is permanently cemented in place. It can be used on any tooth. They are normally used to restore decayed or damaged teeth to their normal shape and size and acts as strengthening tool. Crowns are used

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to protect the structure of tooth that is cracked or broken. They can also be used to change the shape of a tooth, to correct a bite or even fix a cosmetic problem. A crown can be made from gold, or from other materials such as porcelain. If you're after a natural look, you might opt for a porcelain crown, which is matched to the same shade as the rest of your teeth!

Teeth don't fix themselves!




If you have had a toothache in the past but it seems okay now, it could be because you have the first stages of decay and the nerve

of the tooth has retracted slightly to compensate. This is especially so if the original pain lasted only a couple of seconds whilst eating or drinking cold food. The problem though, if left untreated the worst is yet to come!

In any case it's best to have it checked out early so as to stop any future pain and minimise the cost of getting it fixed.
