

A crown is an artificial cover commonly known as "dental caps". It is a dental restoration, which encases a whole tooth and is permanently cemented in place. It can be used on any tooth. They are normally used to restore decayed or damaged teeth to their normal shape and size and acts as strengthening tool. Crowns are used to protect the structure of tooth that is cracked or broken. They can also be used to change the shape of a tooth, to correct a bite or even fix a cosmetic problem. A crown can be made from gold, or from other materials such as porcelain.
